The soprano Alma Ruoqi Sun was born in Harbin, China. She studied at the Hochschule für Musik und Darstellende Kunst in Frankfurt am Main with Henriette Meyer-Ravenstein (Bachelor, 2020) and Michelle Breedt (Master, 2023). During her studies, she took part in masterclasses with Christiane Iven, Brigitte Fassbaender, Capucine Chiaudani, Helmut Deutsch and Franz Hawlata. She was a scholarship holder of Yehudi Menuhin Live Music Now Frankfurt am Main e. V.

In productions at the university, she sang Leonora in THE LONG CHRISTMAS DINNER by Paul Hindemith, Madame Herz in DER SCHAUSPIELDIREKTOR by Mozart, Amor in ORFEO ED EURIDICE by Gluck and Gretel in HÄNSEL UND GRETEL by Humperdinck. In 2018, she appeared as Taumännchen in HÄNSEL UND GRETEL at the Burgfestspiele in Bad Vilbel. In 2021, she made a guest appearance as Cis in Benjamin Britten's ALBERT HERRING at the Nationaltheater Mannheim. In summer 2023, she performed at the International Meistersinger Academy in Neumarkt.

Since the 2023/2024 season, Alma Ruoqi Sun is a member of the Stuttgart State Opera's International Opera Studio and sings the roles of *Frasquita* (CARMEN), *A Voice from Heaven* (DON CARLOS), *Papagena* and *Königin der Nacht* (DIE ZAUBERFLÖTE), as well as Sand- und Taumännchen (HÄNSEL UND GRETEL).
